Week Four

Day 16: “Taste and See”

Discussion Questions:

—Have you ever considered (or even remember a time) where your physical senses brought you more awareness of God?

Practical Application:

As you go about your day, focus on using your God-given senses of touch, taste, sight, smell and sound to actively experience God’s goodness in your everyday life.

Day 17: “In the Waiting”

Discussion Questions:

—Where is an area where you find yourself waiting today? How can you trust during this time that God is working in your waiting?

Practical Application: Take a moment throughout the day where you find yourself waiting—in traffic, on the phone, running errands, whatever it may be—and remind yourself of the promises of scripture that God has for us while waiting.

Day 18: “All for Jesus”

Discussion Questions:

—Do you often find yourself overlooking or taking for granted the everyday gifts God has given?

Practical Application:

—Take one everyday, ordinary task you’re responsible for and spend that time thanking the Lord.

Day 19: “The Invitation to Peace”

Discussion Questions:

—2 Chronicles 20:12 says, “We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you.” Do you have a situation in your life today where you just don’t know what to do? How can you accept Jesus reminder from John 14:27 that He gives us peace “not as the world gives”?

Practical Application:

—What situation in your life is feeling like a battle? I challenge you today to step forward in praise and accept the supernatural peace that is yours through faith in Christ. Turn on the worship music, maybe even sing aloud, and take some time thanking God in advance of the outcome.

Day 20: “Our Great God”

Discussion Questions:

—What is a space in your life you’ve been “seeing” God at work lately?

Practical Application:

—Take a few moments today (or schedule a time coming up) where you can spend sometime outside in God’s creation, thanking Him for the wonderful and goodness of who He is.
